With reference to Panjab University Letter No ST.6309-6314 Dated 04-09-2024 regarding **“GENERAL TRANSITORY REGULATIONS FOR THE STUDENTS ADMITTED TO 3-YEAR UG PROGRAMME”** i.e. Old Students of BA/BSc/BCom/BCA/BBA admitted during 2023-2024, 2022-2023.

“The condition of having passing 50% of the papers at the time of admission to 3rd & 5th is waived off to enable them to attend classes before colleges stop imparting instructions under 3 year programme which has been replaced with 4 year programme. However, they have to complete their course in maximum period as prescribed in the respective regulations.”

All concern admission in charges are requested to complete pending online forms of such students till 10-Sept-2024 to complete the admission process smoothly.

It is informed that the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor on behalf of the Syndicate as per authorization given by the Senate dated 10.02.2024 has approved the following recommendations of the Regulations Committee dated 30.08.2024 vide which Transitory Regulations have been framed for those students of Semester System who will be appearing in the examination in the coming three-four years:

**GENERAL TRANSITORY REGULATIONS FOR THE STUDENTS ADMITTED TO
3-YEAR UNDER-GRADUATE PROGRAMME**

1. These Regulations shall be applicable to students admitted to 3-Year Undergraduate Programme in the year 2022-23 and 2023-2024 in the affiliated Colleges/DES- Multi Disciplinary Research Centre of the University.
2. The condition of having passed at least 50% of the papers at the time of admission to 3rd and 5th semester is waived off to enable them to attend the classes before Colleges stop imparting instructions under the 3-Year Programme which has been replaced with 4-Year Programme. However, they have to complete their course in the maximum period as prescribed in the respective Regulations.
3. The beneficiaries of these Regulations can seek admission within 10 days of the notification of these Regulations.
4. Identical benefit shall be applicable to the students of Centre for Distance and Online Education CDOE as and when CDOE shifts to 4-Year Undergraduate Programme.
